Telehealth?

Simply put, telehealth encompasses all digital healthcare activities including a growing array of at-home technology (apps, devices, and wearables) that track your vital health information, can transmit data to your healthcare providers, and help your providers make more informed healthcare decisions.

Remote Patient Monitoring

Using technology to collect health data (pulse, blood pressure, glucose levels, ketone levels, weight, etc.) from a patient, then transmit that data to healthcare providers for analysis and treatment recommendations.

Telemedicine: often used as a synonym for telehealth, telemedicine actually refers to specific clinical services provided to patients.
